Installation

- Copy desired sound files to the USB drive. Add a unique three-digit number to each filename. Numbers must be consecutive, starting from 001 and up to 099. Insert the USB drive into the player.
- Connect one of the player's two output ports to the phone system's MOH/BGM port. Two output ports of different kind of jacks are provided in order to accommodate different kind of MOH/BGM ports.
- 3. Use the provided power adaptor to power the unit. Caution: using other power adaptor will void the warranty and may damage the unit.
- 4. The LED display will show the file number currently being played. Press the Select button to go to the next file. If you select past the last file the display will show 'AL', which means all files (instead of a single file) will be repeated. Pressing the Select button again will go back to the first file.
- 5. Call from a second line and put it on hold. Listen to the audio and adjust the volume to the proper level. Note that the volume adjustment affects both the output and the internal speaker.
- The internal speaker can be turned on/off by pressing the Speaker button.
 It is provided for audio content verification and trouble-shooting purposes.
 It is recommended to be turned off during normal operation in order to save power consumption.
- 7. The USB drive may be inserted/removed without turning the power off.
- 8. In case of power outages, the player will automatically re-start the same file with the same output volume after power is restored.

Trouble shooting

The power LED is on but there is no sound.

- 1. Make sure the file type is supported.
- 2. Make sure the output volume is turned up.
- 3. Make sure the audio patch cord is securely connected.
- 4. Make sure the file numbers are assigned.

The sound quality is poor.

- 1. Make sure the audio patch cord is securely connected.
- 2. Try turning the volume down a little bit.

The LED display shows two dashes (--).

1. Make sure there is a sound file assigned with file number 001.

The LED display shows/flashes '88'.

1. The USB drive is corrupted or broken. Try reformatting the drive.
